### Social Service Program Income Requirements

The following are basic rules for eligibility, but are not the full set of rules. SSA performs additional calculations to verify eligibility.

#### Medi-Cal for Adults

##### Base Eligibility:

- Ages 19 – 64
- Annual income must be lower than 138% of the federal poverty level

#### CalWORKS

##### Base Eligibility: Applicant must

- Be a child, or have children, and
  - One or both parents are absent from the home, deceased or disabled
  - Both parents are in the home, but the principal wage earner is either unemployed or underemployed
- Have a Social Security number or have applied for one
- Provide proof of regular school attendance for all school age children
- Provide proof of immunizations for all children under the age of 6

#### Food Stamps

##### A Food Stamps household must have at least one citizen or qualified immigrant who:

- Is an Orange County Resident
- Has been in the United States for 5 years, or
- Is receiving disability related assistance or benefits, regardless of entry date
- Is a child under 18 years, regardless of entry date
- Income limits that vary depending on the number of persons in the household and their ages
- Assets are not counted
- SSI/SSP recipients are not eligible for food stamps per State law
